UPDATE ON COVID-19

Attention Residents, Resident Representatives, Families and Staff:

As of today, Honolulu County is experiencing over 17% positivity rate in its community. Hale Ola Kino continues to work diligently around-the-clock to keep both our residents and staff safe.

To give you an update on COVID-19 in our facility:

(The table below indicates whether the exposure is a resident, associate, or contracted worker, including date of confirmed case and status of person.)

On January 4, a fully boosted associate tested positive for COVID-19. The associate last worked on Friday, 12/31/2021 and became symptomatic on January 2, 2022, due to household exposure. An antigen test showed positive on January 2 and was PCR tested yielding a positive result on 1/4/2022. Associate is at home isolating and recovering.

Contact tracing and testing for all associates and residents were completed on Sunday and Monday, January 2 and 3, 2022. One fully boosted, asymptomatic associate tested positive due to household exposure and was sent home for isolation and follow-up PCR testing. On January 4, 2022, PCR test yielded a positive result. Associate remains at home isolating. All other staff and residents resulted in negative results.

All staff and residents will be tested again on Thursday, January 6, 2022.

As a reminder to everyone, DO NOT come to the community if you are experiencing any of the Omicron and/or COVID-19 symptoms or you have been exposed to the virus.
