## UPDATE ON COVID-19

Attention Residents, Resident Representatives, Families and Staff:

As of today, Honolulu County is experiencing over 25% positivity rate in its community. Hale Ola Kino continues to work diligently around-the-clock to keep both our residents and staff safe.

To give you an update on COVID-19 in our facility:
