UPDATE ON COVID-19

Attention Residents, Resident Representatives, Families and Staff:

As of today, Honolulu County community transmission rate is high and is experiencing over 6,000 cases in the past 14 days. Hale Ola Kino continues to work diligently around-the-clock to keep both our residents and staff safe while both residents and staff are 100% boosted.

To give you an update on COVID-19 in our facility as of May 13, 2022:
(The table below indicates whether the exposure is a resident, associate, or contracted worker, including date of confirmed case and status of person.)

On 5/8/2022, a non-direct care, up-to-date vaccinated staff member tested positive for COVID-19. The associate last worked in the community on Friday, 5/6/2022. Contact tracing was completed, and all staff and residents underwent surveillance COVID testing. All tested negative. On 5/12/2022, with continued surveillance testing, two direct care, up-to-date vaccinated staff tested positive for COVID-19 and on 5/13/2022, an up-to-date vaccinated resident tested positive via antigen – PCR is pending. All remaining residents and staff tested negative.

These associates are isolating and recovering at home while the resident will remain on isolation for 10 full days.

We understand this is a very serious situation, and we want you to know that we are approaching it with the utmost care. We will contact you directly if your loved one is suspected or diagnosed with COVID-19. Hale Ola Kino's Infection Preventionist is in

contact with both our Medical Director, Dr. Albert Yazawa, and the State Department of Health for updates and guidance.

As a reminder to everyone, DO NOT come to the community if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms or you have been exposed to the virus.
